2024 Survey Reporting

Sons of Norway has some important reporting requirements that lodges need to participate in annually. Here is an overview of those that should answer commonly asked questions related to them.

Family Lodge of the Year Survey

- Used in part to determine winners of Lodge Achievement Awards given out during conventions.
- Gathers valuable information on heritage and family focused programming to share organization wide.
- Three separate surveys one for each country.
- Lodges with few to no younger members still encouraged to participate to communicate needs and goals.
- Conducted through SurveyMonkey with a link put on the website starting in January.
- Due March 15 of each year.
- Use the draft version to preview questions and gather information ahead of time.
- Data is collected by the SurveyMonkey website and is aggregated in an excel spreadsheet.
- The Fraternal Engagement Manager collects and sorts the survey results to give to the district which includes the raw data and total points.
- Worth a total of 20 pts possible, an additional 5 pts may be earned if submitted by due date.
- Must be submitted through the online Survey Monkey.
- Estimated to take a total of 30 minutes.
- Usually completed by lodge secretary.

Incentive Program

- We highly recommend and ask that all lodges complete these three extremely important reporting surveys. To help encourage and incentivize lodge participation, we are creating a new program for reporting in 2025.
- Must report these and other requirements on time to qualify for Lodge Achievement awards.
- Certificates will be awarded for lodges that qualify according to the following criteria:

FLOY	20 pts (up to)	+5 pts if on time
AFA	10 pts (completion)	+5 pts if on time
D-17	40 pts (completion)	+10 pts if on time
TOTAL	150 pts possible	+25 pts possible
